Activities and Guidelines for Practical Training of Thai Traditional Medicine Program

1) Self-Practical Training is the practical training in Thai traditional medicine in specific field (as specified in the instructional document), advisement, counselling, and solving health problems for the recipients of Thai traditional medicine services while the service provider is on duty or undertaking self-practical training at a health-care facility specified by the University.

2) Assigned Practical Training is the practical training in specific field as the course specified under self-study as case study, observation, practice or trial until obtaining skills assigned with the specifically capable instructor (assigned practical training instructor) who advises and evaluates the training.

3) Skill Supplemental Training is the practical training specified by course characteristics such as various skill supplements, discussion of practical training results, experience sharing, additional study visits, etc. The University will determine the exact time for training at specified places with skill supplemental training instructors appointed by the University to control and evaluate the training.

4) Intensive Training is the practical training relating to personality development, teamwork, analysis of simulation to solve health problems, management with planning, implementation, and work development.

Evaluation

To pass the examinations in all 5 courses, the student has to get a score of not less than 60% for each course.

Practical training in Bachelor of Thai Traditional Medicine curriculum in each course has a number of credits. Types and hours of practice training and evaluation scores. according to the following table.
