- 13903 Seminar on Research Issues Related to Information Science

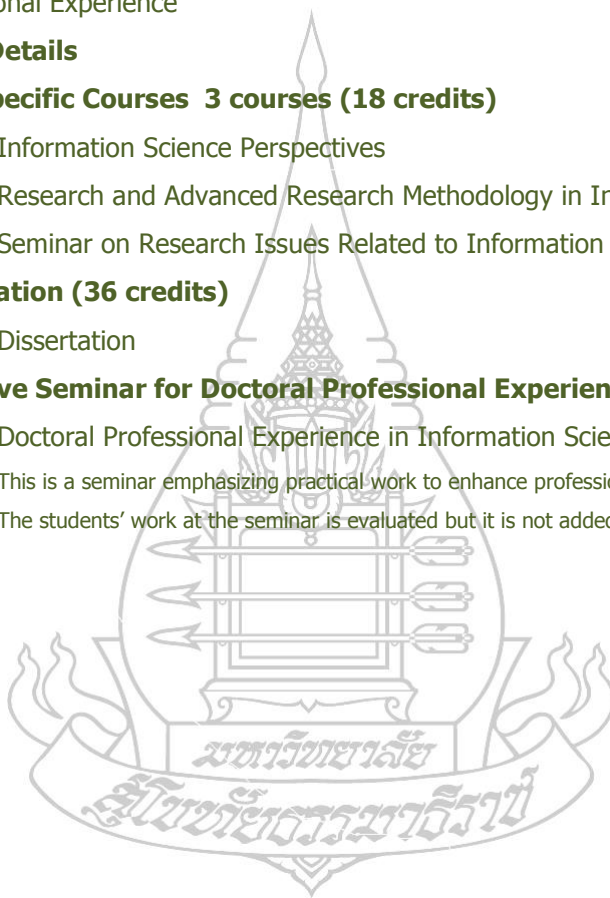
B. Dissertation (36 credits)
