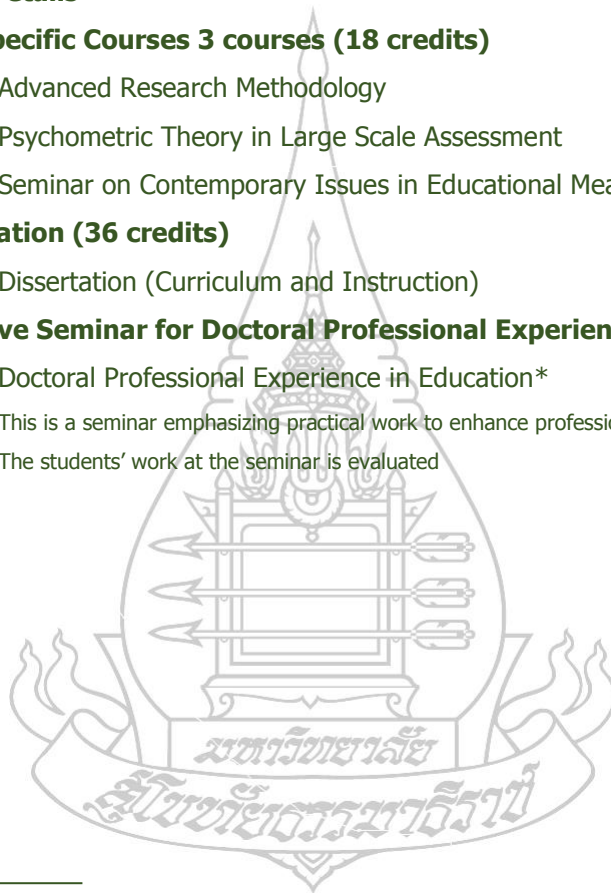
B. Dissertation (36 credits)
