**ABSTRACT** 

The purpose of this research was to develop a web-based information system for the National Film Archive (NFA) that included a film database and information about the NFA and movies. This system offered a convenient, fast and efficient way to access information associated with NFA over the Internet.

The research methodology was based on system development life cycle.

A preliminary study focused on the existing problems. The researcher gathered internal and external information about of the NFA and film preservation. The prototype was further developed and comprised two main components: general information about NFA, including its organization structure, history of film making in Thailand and film preservation; and the film database system and search features. The tools used were ASP (Active Server Pages) and Microsoft Access on the Windows XP platform.

The research resulted in a prototype of NFA web-based information system to be used for the general public.
