

Module 1.4 : Program Orientation Leadership Development and Change Management for Nurse Executives in ASEAN Countries

1. Aims of Face to Face Seminar

- 1.1** To gain knowledge and experiences of leadership for development and change management
- 1.2** To share innovative project, work task or best practice in leadership and management
- 1.3** To build up networking among ASEAN nurses

2. Seminar Activities

The seminar has been set up for 3 days. The activities have been included with (1) special guest speakers from both Thailand and Singapore, (2) poster exhibition: individual innovation or group work task and (3) group activity and presentation.

2.1 Day one, 24th July 2014,

In the morning session, starting with registration and opening ceremony on the first day of Face to Face Seminar ,then following with morning session, A New Paradigm of Learning: Journey from internet to Face to Face Seminar by Assoc.
